

**transcosmos, Brightcove, Dentsu, CCI and J-Stream
Announce Joint Establishment of
Brightcove KK to Provide Internet Video Services for
Media Companies and Marketers**

transcosmos inc. (President & COO: Masataka Okuda; Headquarters: Tokyo;) , Brightcove, Inc. (Chairman & CEO: Jeremy Allaire; Headquarters: Massachusetts, United States), Dentsu Inc. (President & COO: Tatsuyoshi Takashima; Head Office: Tokyo), J-Stream Inc. (Chairman & President: Kiyoshi Shiraishi; Headquarters: Tokyo) and Cyber Communications Inc. (hereafter: CCI; President & CEO: Hideyuki Nagasawa; Head Office: Tokyo) announced today that they have agreed to jointly establish a new company, Brightcove KK. The new company will launch and operate the Brightcove Internet video platform service in Japan. The Brightcove platform service provides capabilities for Internet video content management, publishing video players on websites, distribution, advertising integration, and video viewing analysis. The service, which provides an application platform as a network service, is based on the "Platform as a Service" (PaaS) model.

Background to the Establishment of the New Company

In recent years, the rapid penetration of broadband services means that the technology infrastructure necessary for the provision of Internet-based video content distribution services (sometimes referred to as "Internet TV") is now in place. As a result, many media companies, content providers and marketers are showing increasing interest in launching their own branded Internet video website destinations to distribute original video content. Consequently, there is a strong need in the market for a custom-designed, cost-efficient and high-quality Internet video platform services.

To meet such needs, the five companies participating in today's announcement have decided to combine their respective strengths for the establishment of Brightcove KK, which will provide the Brightcove Internet video platform service. The new company will utilize Brightcove's technology, which is recognized as the leading Internet video service in North America and Europe, while also drawing on the substantial marketing and creative capabilities of Dentsu and CCI in the field of the Internet, and J-Stream's experience and capabilities in supplying video distribution support services.

The agreement announced on this occasion includes the acquisition of marketing rights in Japan for the Brightcove Internet video service to Dentsu, CCI and J-Stream. The three companies plan to market the Brightcove Internet video service principally to media companies, content providers and marketers wanting to distribute video content from their own Internet sites. This will form a key part of their efforts to aggressively develop and grow the video content distribution market in Japan..
